But this is the year to donate since the Plants (pictured below) will match your donation!

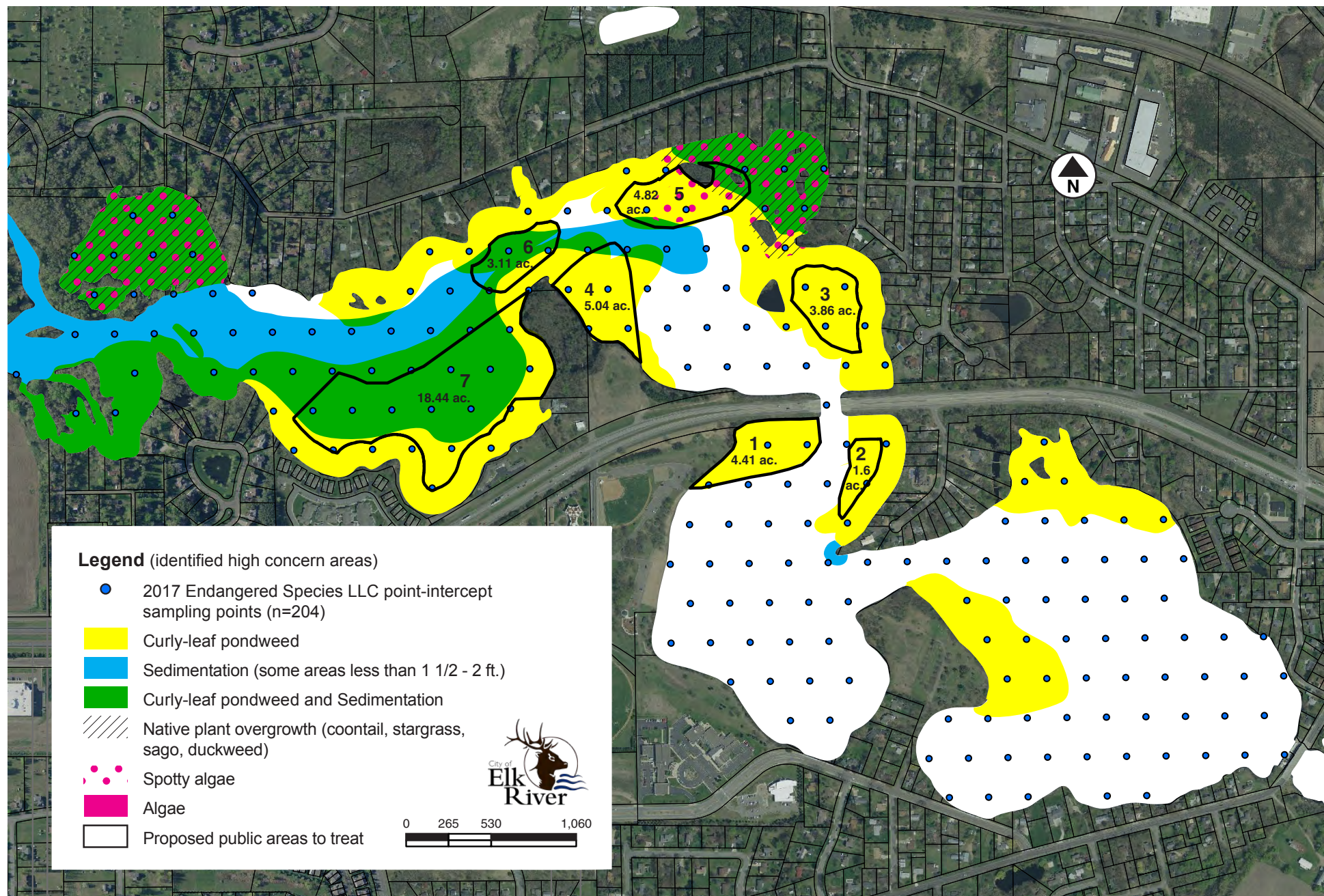
